














FIRST DAY CHECKLIST



✓ Items to Bring

	Water bottle or sippy cup -stays at the school and get washed daily. (preferably with a flip-top or cover for the straw or mouthpiece)
	Small blanket -for nap (if your child naps) -will stay at the school during the week and sent home at the end of your child's week
	A large reusable bag -clearly labeled with your child's first name -to be used for transporting the blanket from the school to home weekly
	Change of clothes -one complete set of clothes including; shirt, pants, socks, undergarments -toilet learning children: 3 bottoms (pants, undergarments and socks)
	Indoor Shoes -will remain at school -easy to put on, 'child-friendly' to promote your child's independence -they should fit and stay securely on the child's feet -we allow hard sole, non-slippery slippers and all leather soft sole slippers (Robeez) as indoor footwear
	Weather Appropriate Outdoor Clothing CHILDREN SPEND TIME OUTDOORS DAILY (WEATHER PERMITTING) Winter: warm clothing; snow pants, boots, mittens, hat, coat, etc. Summer clothing; sun protection hat, sunglasses, etc. Spring/fall; rain gear; boots, raincoat etc.
	All Diapering Items (as needed) - Diapers, wipes, diaper creams and anything else required for diapering (disposable or cloth diapers) An authorization form must be filled out for diaper cream application. ALL CREAMS MUST BE IN ORIGINAL CONTAINERS and IS NOT EXPIRED. -NON-PRESCRIBED cream form -PRESCRIPTION cream form
	Sleep/Rest Pull-On Diapers (Pull-Ups) (as needed) -If your child requires additional protection during nap time, you can send us some pull-on training diapers or thicker training underwear -advise the staff at drop-off that your child requires this for sleeping
	All Required Emergency Medications (as needed) <i>(please make sure the school is aware that your child requires emergency medication and that all required forms have been filled out and submitted)</i> -inhalers, autoinjectors (allergies) -any other medication your child may require due to a chronic medical condition ALL MEDICATIONS MUST BE IN ORIGINAL CONTAINERS and NOT EXPIRED.
	Sunscreen (as needed) MUST BE IN ORIGINAL CONTAINERS and NOT EXPIRED. -during the warmer months, it is recommended by expert that children wear sunscreen daily -the school does not provide sunscreen -authorization label must be filled here
	Any Other Item Necessary For Your Child -comfort item (special small stuffed animal, a picture of family) -we want to minimize any back and forth from school to home, ideal, anything you send should stay at the school for the week -if you MUST get the item sent home daily, please advise us

***All fabric items must be in a sealed plastic bag with your child's name
